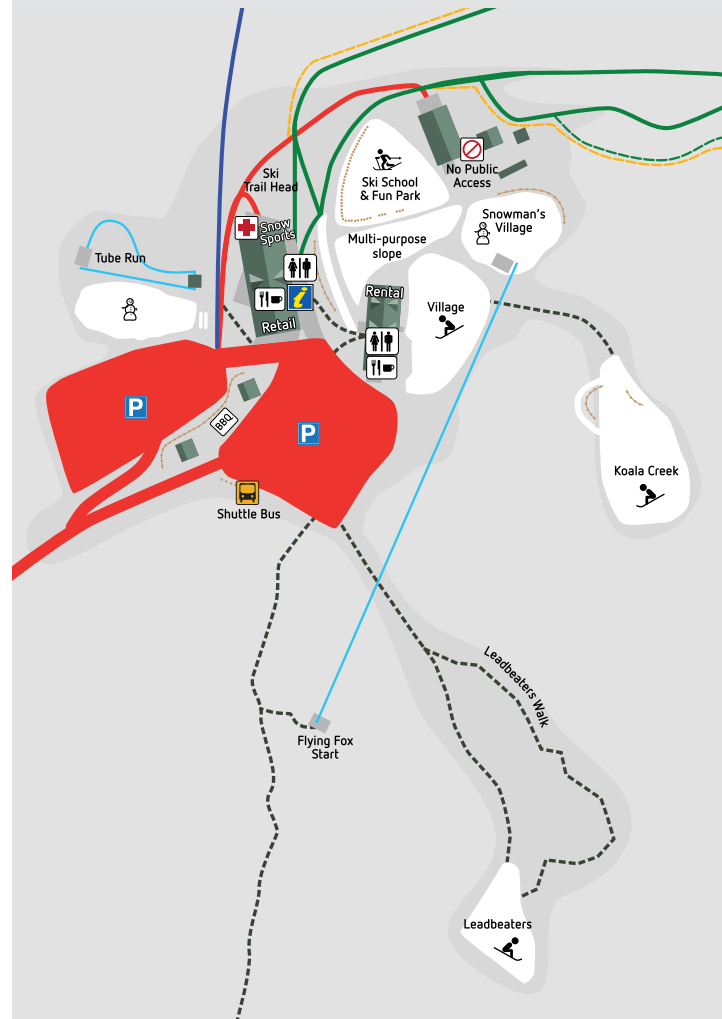

Educational Programs can include:

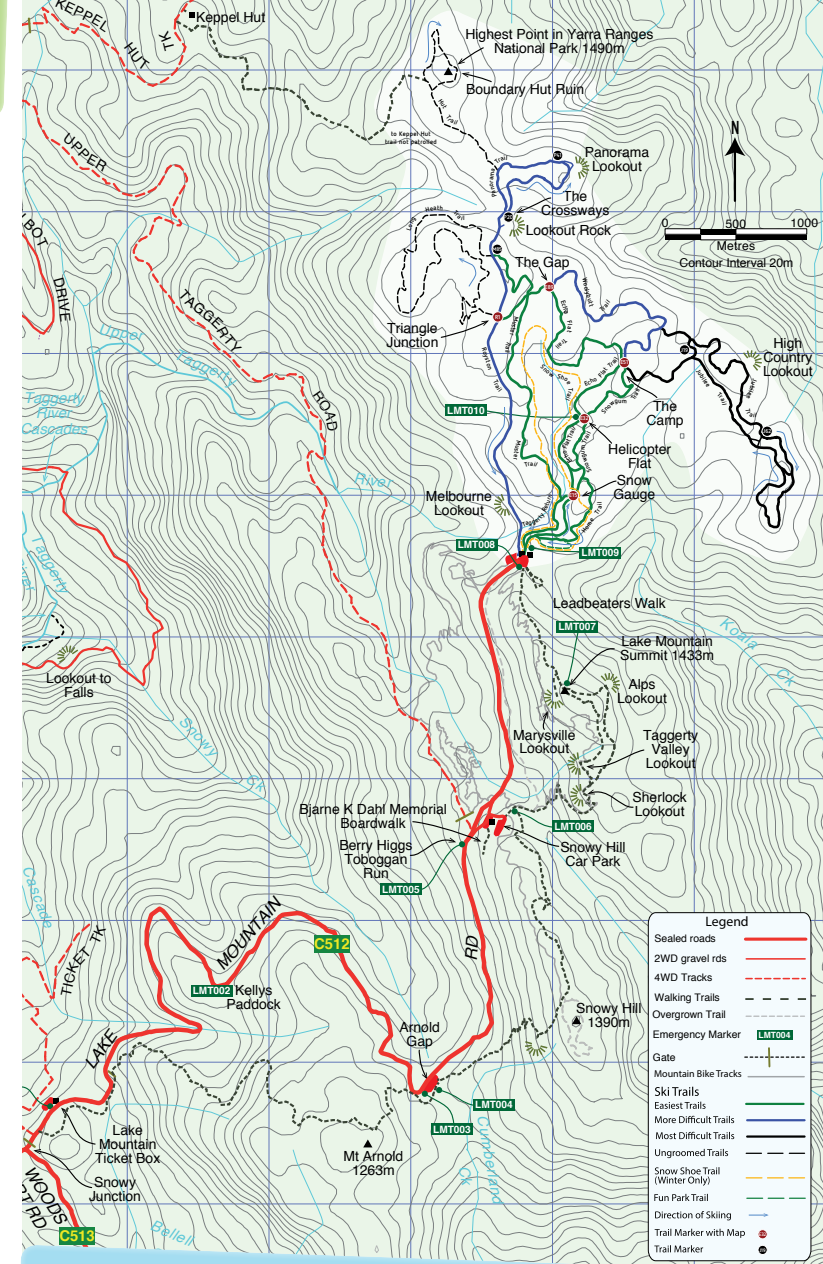
- A presentation on the local environment, including the recent impact of fire and the phenomenal recovery
